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**GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. **Entry Deadline:** Sunday, July 25, 2010
2. **Team Registration:** Monday August 2, 2010, 12:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. at Lincoln Park. All players and coaches are **REQUIRED** to check-in. All players and coaches must present proper ID. ASA ID card which shall include a current photograph, birth date, and signature.
3. **Team Pictures:** Monday, August 2, 2010, after team check-in. **(Players, dress as you like).**
4. **Pool Play Draw/Manager's Breakfast:** One team manager and/or one team representative must be present for the initial Pool Play Draw scheduled for Monday, August 2, 2010. The draw will be held immediately after the Manager's Breakfast scheduled for 9 a.m. at the Clements Center at Lincoln Park. Maximum of 2 representatives per team.
5. **Tournament Draw/Double-Elimination:** The double-elimination brackets will be determined by draw. The double-elimination brackets will be posted immediately following the draw. The draw will be held on Thursday after the completion of pool play at Lincoln Park. Team manager or team representative **must be present for draw.**
6. **Tournament Play:** Scheduled to begin Tuesday, August 3, 2010, 8 a.m., at the various parks.
7. **Opening Ceremonies:** Scheduled for Monday August 2, 2010, 4:30 PM. the Children's Outdoor Performance Area (C.O.P.A.) at Lincoln Park. All teams and families are requested to participate. **(Players, dress as you like).**
8. **Opening Ceremonies Dinner:** Scheduled for Monday August 2, 2010, 6 p.m. – 8 p.m. at C.O.P.A. at Lincoln Park. (Please see Advance Opening Ceremonies Order Form)
9. **Team Gift Exchange:** In the spirit of good sportsmanship, teams will exchange gifts with each team member of the opposing team, prior to the start of their first pool play game (approximately 18 gifts). The gifts should be inexpensive, but thoughtful. They should be based on the kind of gifts the girls, themselves, would like to receive. The following is a few possible gift ideas; items representing the team's home state, team pin, magnets, key chains, beads/jewelry, disposable cameras, autograph/photo albums, lip balm, headbands, etc.
10. **Team Practices:** Team practice fees are \$20 per hour with a two-hour per day maximum. Contact Tom Tengler, 520-574-3826 to schedule.
11. **Practice Games:** Sunday August 1, 2010, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m., satellite fields. Game fees are **\$40 per team**. Fee includes two umpires. Contact Tom Tengler, 520-574-3826 to schedule.



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**HIGHLIGHTED TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All playing rules and regulations shall be governed by the ASA Official Rules of Softball, 2010 edition.
2. A "Run Rule" of fifteen after three full innings, twelve after four full innings and eight after five full innings shall be in effect (ASA Rule 5, Section 9).
3. A "Game Time Limit" of one hour and forty minutes shall be in effect for all pool play and elimination play games, except championship game. (ASA Rule 5, Section 10).
4. Dress Code/Uniforms:
  - a. Players on a team shall properly wear uniforms that are alike in color, trim, and style (ASA Rule 3, Sections 6, A – G).
  - b. Coaches must be neatly attired, dressed alike, or in a team uniform and in accordance with the color of the team.
5. Awards:
  - a. Team trophies – first, second, third, fourth, and (2) fifth places.
  - b. Individual awards – first and second place teams.

(See National Awards, Article 607 of the ASA Code, 2009 Edition, for more information)

6. Miscellaneous Rules and Regulations:
  - a. Format: Two pool play games followed by double-elimination bracket play.
  - b. Line-Up Cards/Home Team: Tournament officials will provide official line-up cards for each team. An official ASA line-up card must be submitted to the Official scorekeeper at least thirty (30) minutes prior to your scheduled game at the coin toss to determine the home team. The coin toss shall be completed by the Tournament Director or UIC at each playing site.
  - c. Game Times: The game times will be listed on the official tournament bracket. Teams need to be prepared to play at the assigned time. Failure to do so may result in a forfeit.
  - d. Infield Practice: No infield practice is permitted during tournament play and warm-up is allowed only in designated areas. No practices allowed on field while staff is prepping the fields.
  - e. Protests: The tournament committee will rule on all protests. Proper protest procedures are included in ASA Rule 9.
  - f. Inclement Weather: In the event of inclement weather, the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was suspended. It is the manager's responsibility to report to the Tournament Director for rescheduling information.

In the event that the tournament cannot be completed within the scheduled time frame and more than 40% of the games have been completed, the official order of finish will be determined in accordance with Article 510 of the ASA Code, 2009 Edition.

- g. Dugouts: The team at the top of the bracket will use the (1) first-base dugout. The team at the bottom of the bracket shall use the (3) third-base dugout (unless one of the teams are playing back to back games).
- h. Official Game Ball: The official ball for the tournament will be approved by the ASA Executive Director in accordance with the ASA Official Rules of Softball, 2009 Edition. The official game ball will be Baden.
- i. Conduct: Managers and/or coaches are expected to have complete control of their players both on and off the playing field in accordance with the ASA Official Rules of Softball, 2009 Edition.
- j. Souvenirs: Souvenirs (i.e., hats, t-shirts, shorts, trading pins, etc.) will be available at Lincoln Park throughout the week and weekend.
- k. Items Prohibited: An entry gate monitor will be stationed to assure compliance. The following items are prohibited in the softball complex are:
  - No outside food or beverages (exception: one unopened water bottle or sports drink).
  - No coolers/ice chests/boxes (exception: one team cooler with unopened water bottles, sports drinks, and fresh fruit). *Water coolers will be provided in each dugout.*
  - No cans, glass bottles, and/or fireworks.
  - No animals and pets. Exception: certified service animals.
  - No bicycling, skateboarding, rollerblading, Heely's, large riding toys and/or distracting or noise-making toys.
  - No smoking allowed at Lincoln Park. Designated smoking areas are provided outside the complex. No alcohol, smoking, or use of tobacco products is allowed at Lincoln Park.
